

## RETIRED SENIOR VOLUNTEER PROGRAM/RSVP – FAQ

- **How old must I be to join RSVP?** – To join RSVP you must be 55 and older, however to volunteer for RSVP you must be 18 and older.
- **Do I have to be retired in order to join RSVP?** – No you can still work full time or part time and still become a member of RSVP.
- **Who decides where and how I volunteer?** – You make the decision as to where you want to volunteer.
- **Do I have to volunteer a minimum of hours?** – No, you can volunteer as little as one hour a month, it depends upon your flexibility and the needs of the volunteer site.
- **Am I covered by insurance while volunteering?** Yes, each RSVP volunteer is covered by insurance to and from their home to the volunteer station/site.
- **What is a Volunteer Station/Volunteer Site?** – A Volunteer Station/Site is the place where the volunteer has agreed to volunteer.
- **Can I get paid for my travel?** – Yes, a volunteer in good standing can get paid \$.20 per mile for their travel to and from volunteer site, but the maximum paid to a volunteer per month for mileage can not exceed \$25.00.
- **Can I volunteer at more than one site?** – Yes, you can volunteering at numerous sites of your choice.
- **Will I receive training?** – Yes, each volunteer site will provide training for new volunteers.
- **Can I change volunteer sites if I want?** – Yes we ask that if you change sites, you contact the RSVP office of your decision.
